This therapeutic mentoring course is planned to train an army of people to respond as nurses to traumatised people to work alongside the doctors and specialists and so respond to the urgent need to facilitate recovery to many.

Currently we can see in statistics that there is an urgency for people to train in effective methods to help children and young people recover from trauma.

Even more so with the current pandemic causing increased stress and trauma for many. The Certificate in Therapeutic Mentoring (CTM) has had around 400 students over the last 10 years. It started as an in person training in Bath and then Oxford and is now also online.
